Euskal Herriari oso eskertuta

Donald Sutherland aktore oportunoak oso eskertuta jaso zuen Donostia Saria, atzo, Zinemaldiko zuzendari Jose Luis Rebordinosen eskuak. "Niretzat plazer bat da Euskal Herrian egotea, pozez zoratzan nago", esan zuen 150 film baino gehiago egin dituen aktore kanadiarrak. Oscar sarridunak hunkituta jarraitu zuen bere hitzaldiarekin: "Aspalditik mirestu eta begiratu zaituztet, eta sekulako errespetua daukat zuenganako; poz handia sentitzen dut gaur hemen nagoelako; Euskal Herria". Eta hasi duen bezalaxe bukatu du hitzaldia, euskaraz: "Mila esker, Euskal Herria, Euskal Herria, Euskal Herria!".

Kursaalen ospatu zen galaren aurkezle Edurne Ormazabalek gogora ekarri zuen moduan, film ahaltezinetan parte hartu du Sutherland eta historiako zinemagile garrantzisuenekin lan egin-dakoa da, hala nola, Fellini, Alda, Bertolucci, Aldrich, Trumbo, Eastwood eta Chabrol. Gainera, zenbait proiektu berri dauzka estreinatzeko. Esaterako, atzoko ekitaldiaren baitan ikusgai egon zen *The Burnt Orange Heresy*.



A prolific career spanning five decades

Introduced as "a legend of cinema," Donald Sutherland received the second of this year's Donostia Awards last night at a ceremony that paid tribute to a prolific career spanning five decades.

After an overview of his acting curriculum that has included such classics as Robert Altman's *M.A.S.H.*; Bernardo Bertolucci's *1900*; Nicolas Roeg's *Don't Look Now*; Robert Redford's *Ordinary People*; and Federico Fellini's *Casanova*, the director of the Festival, José Luis Rebordinos presented the Canadian actor with the award. The audience in the Kursaal gave him a standing ovation as he said, "It is such a pleasure to be in the Basque Country. I have long honoured and admired and watched you and have great joy to be with you tonight. It's a great honour for me and I'm delighted. Mila esker, Euskal Herria."

The gala was immediately followed by a screening of *The Burnt Orange Heresy*. Its director, Giuseppe Capotondi, presented this thriller in which Sutherland appears alongside Claes Bang, Elizabeth Debicki and Mick Jagger.
