One single card

**Anyone
can use it**

The card isn't tied to just one person. Anyone can use it, without the need for extra paperwork. **You really do just have to arrive, buy and get moving.**

**Save from your
very first trip**

Every trip is 60% cheaper. The card costs just €5 and you can top it up in multiples of €5.

**Travel as a group
with just one card**

The **MUGI ANÓNIMA** card allows you to pay for a series of bus tickets, perfect when travelling with friends, family or as a couple.

GROUPS: DO NOT VALIDATE YOUR CARD WHEN GETTING ON OR OFF. SHOW IT TO THE DRIVER, WHO WILL VALIDATE IT FOR YOU.

How to use it

On buses

- Hold the card against the **validator when you get on.**
- On Lurraldebus intercity buses, remember to **validate when you get off as well**, to be charged the right fare.
- **To travel in a group** (maximum 9 people):
 - **On intercity buses (Lurraldebus)**, the first person should hand the card to the driver for them to perform the operation, in which case you will not need to validate it again when getting off.
 - **On urban buses**, validate once for each passenger when getting on.

On trains

(Euskotren and Renfe Cercanías)

- **Validate your card just once when boarding.**
On trains, only one person can use it per trip.

Transfers and duration

- The **MUGI ANÓNIMA** card allows free transfers, which are automatic.
- **It remains active for 12 months** from the last top-up. If it is deactivated through lack of use, you don't lose the balance: just top it up again.

Where to buy and top up your card

- **Cards are available at most tourist offices in Gipuzkoa**, newsagents, tobacconists and stations. Top-ups only at Euskotren and Renfe.
